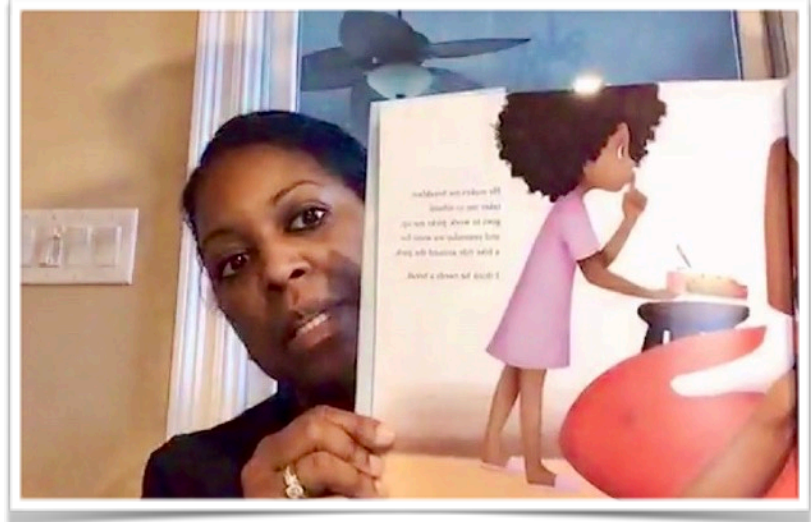

3. Everyone, hold each other accountable.

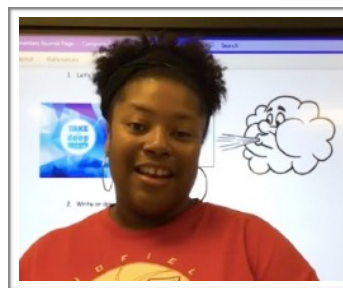
If we can all agree that every member is vital to the success of this team, then I see victory in sight for Midfield.

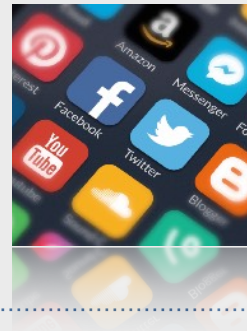
