It is our desire to serve our students with the optimum love and resources possible. Thusly, we have created a menu of options to meet the needs of providing a breakfast item and lunch for our students. Because we are creating this service with the safety of our students and employees in mind, we are executing this endeavor with social distancing to follow the guidance of national leadership, state leadership, county leadership, city leadership, and other health officials. As we have been informed, our actions relating to how we respond to COVID 19, is critical in ensuring the safety of our essential employees, students, families, and community members.

Beginning April 13, 2020, we will continue to deliver 5 days of breakfast and lunch items; however, we will only operate this service on Mondays and Thursdays of each week. On Mondays, we will have breakfast and lunch items that are prepared to last for Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday. On Thursdays, we will have breakfast and lunch items that are prepared to last for Thursday and Friday. Please adhere to the following menu of options for receiving the breakfast and lunch to go within Midfield City Schools.

Option A: Walk or Drive Through Service

Locations are Midfield Elementary School and Rutledge Middle School from 10:30 a.m. until 11:30 a.m. After which, our community partner, United Fellowship Community Baptist Church will assist us by receiving additional lunches to give to our students who are 18 years or younger from 12 noon until 1p.m.

Option B: Delivery of Lunches to Bus Stops

We deliver our meals to go to 10 bus stops that would service students who are not able to receive a lunch from our school locations. We begin our bus stop deliveries at 10:30 and our buses remain at each stop for minimally 10 minutes before traveling to the next stop. The following is a listing of our bus stops and times of delivery for our meals to go:
