Arrival Procedure

CAR RIDERS:

- Kindergarten students and siblings: Drop off at Kindergarten back door
- Grades 1 - 4: Drop off at Main Entrance
- Students will enter the building through the body temperature scan entrance report directly to homeroom

BUS RIDERS:

- Drop off on side of cafeteria and students will enter through the cafeteria
- Students will enter the building and have their temperature scan by a member of admin and report directly to homeroom

WALKERS:

- Enter through the 4th grade hallway side door
- Students will enter the building and have their temperature scan by a member of admin and report directly to homeroom

SUPERVISORY PERSONNEL

- Homeroom teachers will be in their classroom awaiting students to ensure social distancing
- Non-homeroom teachers and para will be strategically placed around the building ensure appropriate social distancing as students move
- Admin will work at each entrance to scan for temperatures

Dismissal Procedure

CAR RIDERS:

- Car Riders will remain in the classroom and await for their name to be called via the intercom
- Car riders will receive a name tag to display on their dash to have their name called via walkie to the main office
- Non-homeroom teachers/librarian will be assigned to help with this process each day
- Car riders will be picked up in the cafeteria

BUS RIDERS:

- Bus riders will be dismissed by bus name and class via announcements from the office
- Bus riders will walk down the ramp and exit near the gymnasium to load the bus

WALKERS:

- Walkers will be dismissed first each day to allow them time to transition out of the building and to the corner with the support of a staff member

21st CENTURY

- Dismissed last by homeroom to their assigned location

SUPERVISORY PERSONNEL

- Admin & other personnel who do not have a class will monitor the hallways and student transitions to the buses and cars

Arrival Procedure

CAR RIDERS:

- Will be dropped off in the front of the building
 - Students will enter the building through the body temperature scan entrance near the front of the building and report directly to homeroom
- ### BUS RIDERS:
- Bus Riders will unload in the bus unloading zone in the rear of the building
 - Students will enter the building through the body temperature scan entrances near the gymnasium and report directly to homeroom
 - Homeroom teachers will be in their classrooms awaiting students to ensure social distancing
 - Non-homeroom teachers and paras will be strategically placed around the building to ensure appropriate social distancing as students move to class

• Counselors/Librarian will work at each entrance to scan for temperatures

• Admin will supervise the halls and entrances to foster safety measures

Dismissal Procedure

CAR RIDERS:

- Car riders will receive a name tag to display on their dash to have their name called via walkie
- Assigned teachers will escort car riders to the cafeteria and wait for their ride home
- Students will exit the side entrance of the front of the building near the cafeteria

BUS RIDERS:

- Bus riders will be dismissed by bus name and class via announcements from the office
- Bus riders will walk down the ramp and exit near the gymnasium to load the bus

WALKERS, ATHLETES & 21ST CENTURY

- Walkers, athletes, and 21st Century students will be dismissed last each day to allow time for the elementary students bus to arrive to walk home with older siblings and for staff to supervise extra-curricular activities

LEARNING OPTIONS

1. Hybrid/Blended

- 5th/7th Monday & Wednesday
- Remote learning (Tuesday, Thursday, & Friday)
- 6th/8th Tuesday & Thursday
- Remote learning (Monday, Wednesday, & Friday)
- Friday (All students will work from home) - Social Emotions/Makeup/Electives
- Students with IEPS/struggling students will attend school for in person instruction Monday - Thursday.
- RMS will use a flipped classroom model (blended learning) that enables teachers more class time for intentional instructional. Coursework will be extended through research based online platforms.

- Students that opt to enroll in a full virtual learning model, will participate in remote learning from home with support from a credentialed Midfield City teacher.
- Virtual attendance will be taken
- Daily instruction and support will be provided.

MCS will be prepared to move all students to virtual only instruction based on a State and/or local decision about closures as a result of an increase in COVID-19 spread.

Arrival Procedure

- Upon bus and car drop off students will enter the building at the atrium entrance.
- One grade level will report to the right side of the gym and the other grade level will report to the left side of the gym.
- Students will spread out to adhere to social distancing.
- Temperatures will be scanned at the gym doors.
- Students who clear the temperature scan will report to the security checkpoint table located in the gym.
- If a student temperature reads over 100 degrees, the student will be escorted to the Alternative Building to our designated Quarantine Room.
- Parents will be notified to pick up students who display symptoms.
- Students will report to Homeroom by class and will be escorted in the building by their homeroom teachers.

Dismissal Procedure

- Students will remain in 4th block class and listen for announcements.

1. Hybrid/Blended

- A Day-** Mondays and Wednesdays-Grades 9 and 10 will report to campus and follow their schedule.
- B Day-** Tuesdays and Thursdays-Grades 11-12 will report to campus and follow their schedule.
- Departments will co-teach to keep class sizes at a minimum.
- Teachers will utilize a blended learning model through Acellus and Google Classroom
- Fridays- All students will work from home focusing on social/emotional learning classes assigned through Acellus and Intervention.
- Tutoring/Enrichment will be provided on Fridays by request.
- Self Contained SPED students will report to campus Monday-Thursday.
